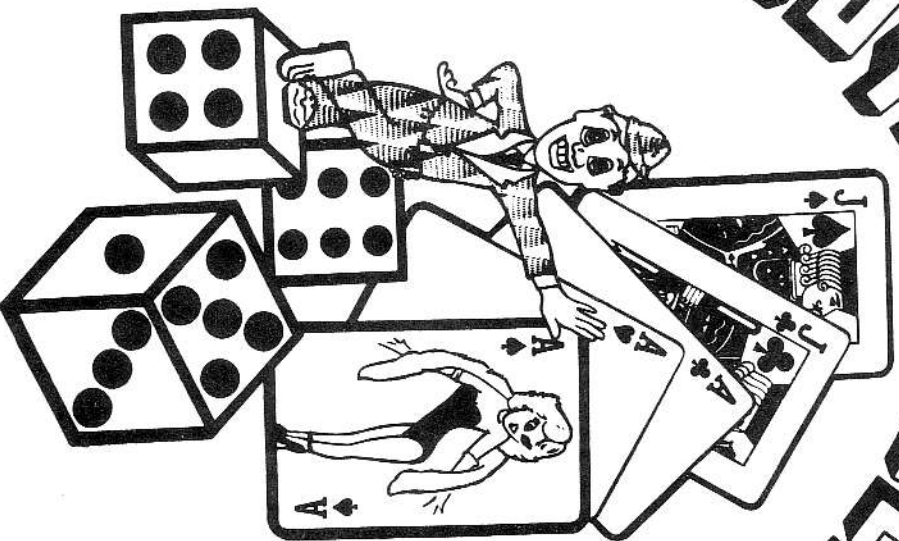

A.C.T.'s inaugural production was "YOU CAN'T TAKE IT WITH YOU," staged in the Fall of 1981. Productions since that time have included "THE FANTASTICKS," "HARVEY," "PLAZA SUITE," "GEORGE WASHINGTON SLEPT HERE," "THE SOUND OF MUSIC" and "OKLAHOMA." A.C.T. is especially grateful for those persons who have tried to attend each show. It is with this base of support and loyalty that A.C.T. embarked on the current season.

The 1985-86 season opened in September with the critically reviewed "INHERIT THE WIND," A.C.T.'s first dramatic offering. In december, A.C.T. brightened the holiday scene locally with central Iowa's first presentation of Barbara Robinson's warm and charming work, "THE BEST CHRISTMAS PAGEANT EVER." And now, A.C.T. is happy and proud to share it's seasons finale with you - "GUYS & DOLLS," a delightful musical fable of Broadway based on a story and characters of Damon Runyon.
