

During the past year and a half, Stacie has become a person who goes camping!



Brad Church (Edmund) is happy to be returning to the ACT stage for the first time since 2019 when he was seen in Kiss Me, Kate (Fred Graham/Petruchio). Brad made his ACT debut in 2018 playing Father Flynn in Doubt. He has performed at the Des Moines Playhouse in The Diary of Anne Frank, The Music Man, Mamma Mia, Willy Wonka, and Spamalot. Her theater experiences include acting, directing, costume design, and a bit of set & light design at ACT, Iowa Stage Theatre, Des Moines Playhouse, Tallgrass Theatre, CAP, and Iowa Falls/ECC before moving to Des Moines. She and her husband, Max, have three daughters and four grandchildren.



Lauren Mills (Zoey) first appeared on the ACT stage as Mrs. Frank in *The Diary of Anne Frank* two years ago. She almost made it to the stage in *A Piece of My Heart* in March of 2020 and looks forward to reprising her role in October! Lauren works across central Iowa as a sign language interpreter. In her spare time, she likes to paint, bake new recipes, and listen to audiobooks. Lauren is a member of the ACT Board of Directors and serves as Marketing Chair.



Frances Paterik (Esther) has done forty shows in forty years on stages like the Ingersoll Dinner Theatre, Des Moines Community Playhouse, and Tallgrass Theatre. She appeared on the ACT stage in the show *Musical Chairs* for which she was nominated as Favorite Supporting Actress. Frances is a retired music teacher from the Des Moines Public Schools, but continues to work as a substitute.

But to hear actors speak words I've written and bring my characters to life – and hear the laughter and applause of an audience -- that's the greatest thrill I've ever known in theater!" "I'm not writing about them, but I couldn't have dreamed up this script without Katherine and Anne!" By day, John is a Director of Philanthropy at Lutheran Services in Iowa.
